

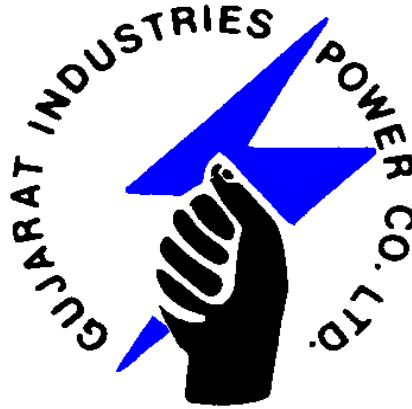

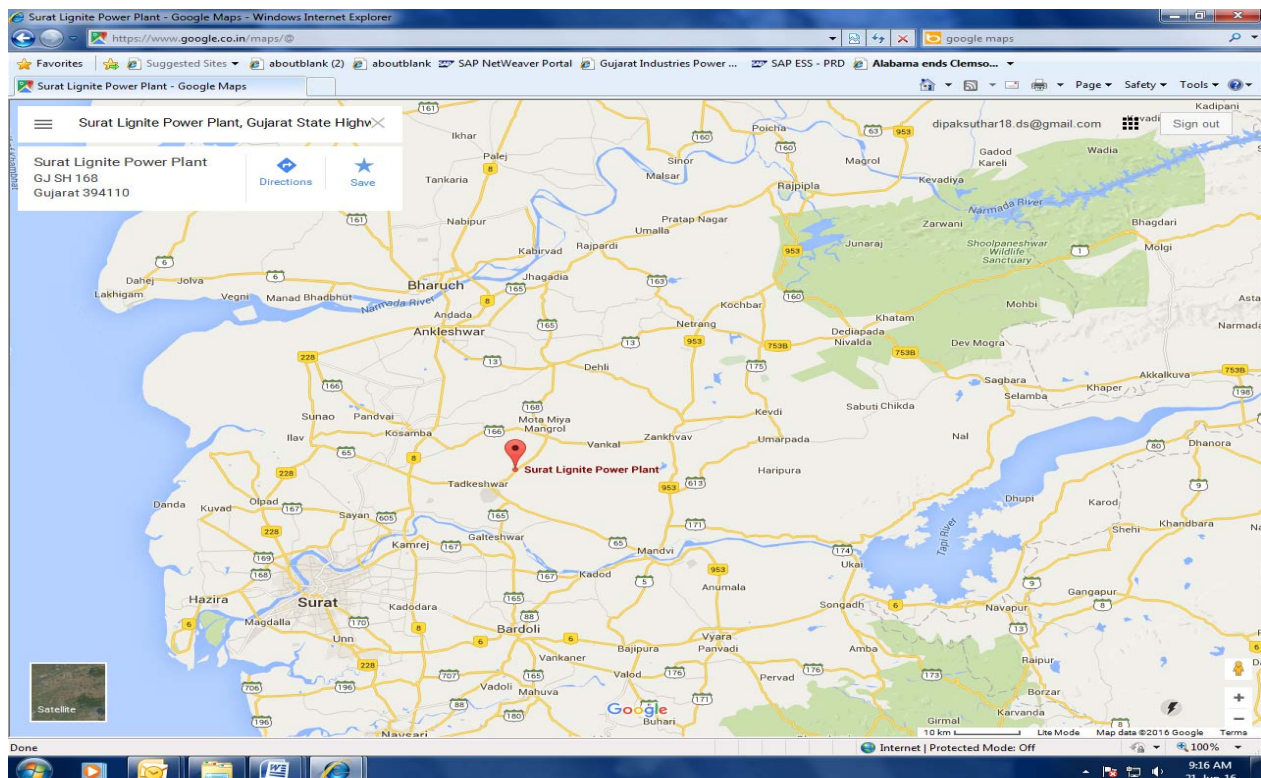
Sub: 4X125MW Surat Lignite Power Plant: On line tender “Annual rate contract for erection & commissioning of above ground MS/GI piping for miscellaneous jobs of BOP” through GIPCL e-tender portal.

1. PLANT SYNOPSIS

Gujarat Industries Power Company Limited (GIPCL) (henceforth be named Company/GIPCL), is a Premier Power Utility in the State of Gujarat with an installed capacity of 924. 4 MW and 5 MW Solar Power Plant. GIPCL has commissioned 1 MWp Distributed Solar Power Projects at two locations in Gujarat viz. at Village: Amrol, Dist.: Anand and at Village: Vastan, Taluka Mangrol, Dist.: Surat. The company has set up 112.4 MW capacities of Wind Power Projects as on March-2017 in the State of Gujarat at different sites. GIPCL has successfully commissioned 80 MW (2 x 40 MW) PV Solar Power Projects at Gujarat Solar Park, Charanka, Dist.: Patan on Sept.-2017.

Surat Lignite Power Plant (SLPP) with four units of 125 MW capacities each is located at Village: Nani Naroli, Taluka: Mangrol, District: Surat in Gujarat. GIPCL has also operating its own captive Lignite and Lime Stone Mines close to the Power Plant. The Power Plant is based on Circulating Fluidized Bed Combustion (CFBC) technology for the Boilers, where Lignite is burnt along with Lime Stone in the Combustor of the Boiler.

Surat Lignite Power Plant (SLPP) is accessible by road from Kim and Kosamba, which are on Mumbai-Ahmedabad highway. From Kosamba, SLPP is around 32 KM, out of which 27 KM is part of the National & State Highway and balance 5 KM is District Road. From Kim, SLPP is around 18 KM, out of which 13 KM is the State Highway and balance 5 KM is District Road. The nearest Broad Gauge Railway Line is at Kim, which is around 21 KM from the SLPP. Surat is approximately 50 KM from the SLPP. Location Map for SLPP is as under.



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The Company intends to award annual rate contract for erection & commissioning of above ground MS/GI piping for miscellaneous jobs of BOP areas and is therefore inviting tenders online through GIPCL e-tender portal from experienced & resourceful contractors.

2. SCOPE OF WORK

- ❖ Erection & commissioning of above ground MS/GI pipe lines including fire hydrant posts, water monitors, isolation valves & pipe supports at suitable distance as per the direction of Engineer-in-charge.
- ❖ In case of underground modification work, connecting newly erected above ground pipe lines with existing underground piping system at various locations of plant premises as well as outside of plant premises with isolation valves wherever required.
- ❖ All hydrant system pipes are MS black ERW pipe. 150NB pipe & below conform to IS: 1239, Part-II (Heavy grade). 200NB pipe & above are as per IS: 3589.
- ❖ All underground pipe system with road crossing is to be coated with anticorrosive paint with metal Hume pipes.
- ❖ One coat of primer (red oxide) and two coat of synthetic/enamel paint to be applied after proper cleaning of pipelines & supports with suitable colour code.
- ❖ While welding GI pipes with MS fittings, welding electrodes shall be at par for GI piping work.
- ❖ Areas are to be covered under fire spray system are boiler bunker floors, New PCH, New SCH, old PCH, old SCH etc. which are at elevation of 40meter height & all lignite conveyor galleries which are at elevation of 30-40meter height.
- ❖ The erection of spray system is to be executed in a highly lignite dusty environment & fire prone areas. Hence, utmost care shall be taken to complete the work without any fire accidents.
- ❖ For spray line erection, dedicated two separate gangs are to be engaged to carry out the work on war footage basis.
- ❖ Scope of work also includes dismantling of old piping system from the pipe rack by cutting for re-use. The dismantled pipes shall be removed from location & to be stored at proper location as per direction of Engineer in charge.
- ❖ Issuing of material from GIPCL stores and transportation to work place and proper stacking at workplace.
- ❖ All materials like pipes, fittings, valves, gasket and structure steel will be supplied by GIPCL.
- ❖ Total piping quantities described under contract are for one year. Party will be called as & when required based on material availability. Prior intimation will be given to party for gang mobilization for piping work.
- ❖ Scope of work area shall be from ELHS mine to river water pump houses (Patna & Bodhan)
- ❖ The quantities mentioned in tender are approximated & may change without variation in unit rate quoted

3. CONTRACT PERIOD:

Contract period shall be **one** year from the date of issue of the work order. However, the period can be extended further if mutually agreed upon by both the parties.

4. BID VALIDITY:

Bid shall be kept valid for 90days from the date of offer.

5. EARNEST MONEY DEPOSIT (EMD):

Bidders shall be required to submit Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) of ₹. 25,000 **on or before the last date for submission of bid in the** form of cheque or demand draft only. EMD received in this form shall be kept in safe custody of Finance Dept. The same will be refunded to unsuccessful bidders, as soon as the price bid is opened and L1 party is declared. The Demand Draft should be in favour of "Gujarat Industries Power Co. Ltd." as per following details.

No interest shall be payable on EMD.

6. SUBMISSION OF PRICE BID:

The price bids shall be submitted electronically through GIPCL E-tender system solution portal <https://www.gipcl.com> only.

The price shall be inclusive of all man-power, consumables, tools and tackles, transportation, safety and statutory compliance, taxes and duties, mobilization and demobilization etc as per scope of work covered in this tender. GST shall be quoted separately in the tender format.

All bidders are requested to visit the SLPP site for better understanding about scope of work before quoting.

7. PRE QUALIFICATION CRITERIA:

- Bidder should possess minimum Three years of experience out of last five years in similar nature of jobs like erection & commissioning of MS/GI/SS pipes and should enclose proof of the same. Bidder shall submit necessary evidence for the same like attested copies of work orders along with work completion certificates from clients. The work completion certificate shall comprise of Order value & Executed value. Bidders should have executed the work directly. The work executed as a sub-contractor or subletting agency shall not be taken in to consideration.
- Bidder should have annual turnover of Rs. 2.27 Lakh for last three financial years. Bidder shall furnish annual audited financial statement duly certified by Chartered Accountant for the last three financial years to demonstrate the financial healthiness of the company. The balance Sheet must be in the name of the company. Any type of MOU for this purpose will not be entertained.

Note: In case, the annual turnover is less than the statutory guideline which does not require audit, the bidder shall submit the turnover certificate from Chartered Accountant.

- If Bidder or its Partner(s) or Director(s) is /are/was in any Litigation(s), Court Case(s) or Arbitration(s), either completed or under progress during last five (5) years or Black Listed / Deregistered / Stopped or banned from dealing in the past by any Govt, of Gujarat Undertakings / Depts. / Authorities and Govt. of Gujarat supported companies / undertakings / organizations, Bid of that party will be liable to be rejected. Bidder agrees and undertakes to accept decision of GIPCL in this regards as final and binding on the Bidder without any demur and that no further correspondence shall be done in this regard at any stage. (**Annexure-N, Form** attached.)

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- Bidder shall have to submit the “Declaration-cum-Undertaking for Compliance of Safety Laws and Regulations” (**Annexure-M, Form attached.**)
- If any Fatal Accident / Violation of any safety law(s) / Rule(s) is / are found during the preceding Three (3) years, Bid of that party will be liable to be rejected. Bidder agrees and undertakes to accept decision of GIPCL in this regards as final and binding on the Bidder without any demur and that no further correspondence shall be done in this regard at any stage.
- If any of the details submitted in the prescribed Annexure / Form to the Bid is/are found to be false, incorrect at any time in future, then the Contract awarded to that Bidder / Contractor shall be liable to be terminated forthwith without any notice / correspondence and Bidder agrees and undertakes to accept decision of GIPCL in this regards as final and binding on the Bidder without any demur and that no further correspondence shall be done in this regard at any stage.

Further, Performance / Security Deposit will also be liable to be forfeited. Any dues to GIPCL from the Bidder / Contractor shall be recovered from the pending bills or any other dues payable to the Bidder / Contractor, if any or otherwise through any other recourse available under the Laws.

8. CONTRACT PERFORMANCE GUARANTEE / SECURITY DEPOSIT:

As a Contract Security, the successful Bidder, to whom the work is awarded, shall be required to furnish a Performance Bank Guarantee (PBG)/Contract security deposit in favour of Gujarat Industries Power Company Limited for guarantee amount at ten percent **(10%)** of the “Annualized Contract Price” from any Nationalized Bank including Public Sector bank-IDBI Ltd or AXIS Bank, HDFC Bank, ICICI Bank or Kotak Mahindra bank, Yes Bank, Ratnakar Bank, IndusInd Bank, Karur Vysya Bank, DCB Bank, ING Vyasaya Bank or The Kalupur Commercial Co-operative Bank Ltd, Rajkot Nagrik Sahakari Bank Ltd, The Ahmedabad Mercantile Co-operative bank Ltd, The Mehsana Urban Co-operative Bank Ltd, Nutan Nagrik Sahakari Bank Ltd in the format attached in **SECTION-F**, and it shall guarantee the faithful performance of the 'Contract' in accordance with the terms and conditions specified in these documents and specifications. Contract security deposit shall be submitted strictly within twenty one days from the date of Lol or work order, whichever is earlier. The guarantee shall be valid up to retention period of twelve months from the contract completion date. The Guarantee amount shall be payable to the Company in Bidder's home currency without any condition whatsoever.

The Performance Bank Guarantee (initial security deposit) will be returned to the Vendor/Contractor without any interest at the end of the 'Retention Period' after completion of contract and on fulfilling contractual obligations throughout the retention period. However, any delay in submission of initial SD will result in equivalent late release of entire SD after guarantee period.

9. TERMS OF PAYMENT:

The contractor shall raise the invoice in duplicate after completion of work on monthly basis / pro-rota basis and the payment of the same shall be made within 21 days thereafter as per the following terms of payment.

1. 100% of bill along with 100% taxes shall be released against the work executed duly certified by GIPCL. Income Tax (IT) will be deducted at source from monthly RA bills as per the rules in force.

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2. GST shall be paid along with bills after fulfillment of following terms.
 - a. Submission of copy of registration certificate issued by GST Authority (to be furnished only once).
 - b. Citing GIPCL GST no. (I.e. 24AAACG7277Q1Z0) along with Bidder GST registration no and the date of issue of registration certificate on invoices. Claim of GST amount with percentage (%) separately shown on the invoices.
 - c. The contractor shall be required to submit the proof of payment of GST of previous month/quarter, as may be applicable as & when demanded by GIPCL/Owner/company.
 - d. The Bidder shall inform the Owner in the event of its registration certificate is cancelled or discontinued for whatsoever reason.

Party shall submit material reconciliation report along with every RA / Monthly bill.

10. MOBILIZATION TO SITE:

This annual rate contract is purely base on as & when required. Advance intimation shall be given to party for mobilization base on availability of spares. However, In case of outages/emergency, party has to mobilize required Gang/tools & Tackles within 24 hrs from our intimation.

11. SCHEDULE OF DEVIATIONS:

Wherever the Bidder deviates from the general specifications, the same shall be listed out in the 'Schedule of Deviations' attached as ANNEXURE-E to these specifications. No technical deviation is permitted. Only those deviations which are listed in this Annexure shall be considered. Deviation indicated elsewhere, shall be rejected.

12. RECOVERY CLAUSE:

In case of any damage to equipment / machinery due to negligence of contractor or any other reasons attributed to contractor the decision of engineer in charge regarding the amount of recovery shall be final and binding. However the amount shall be restricted to 10% of contract value.

If the contractor fails to execute the work as per directions of GIPCL's Engineer (I/C) within the time frame given. GIPCL shall get the work done from any other contractor and the cost of execution of such work along with 20% overhead charges of GIPCL shall be deducted from contractor's monthly bills over and above recovery as per sub clause 1 above.

Party shall preserve the materials like pipes; bends, flanges, valves, piping fittings, bolts, paints etc. issued to for execution of the jobs & shall guard it properly against theft or pilferage. In case of theft of materials issued to the party, appropriate amount (equivalent to the cost of the pilferage material) will be recovered from their bill.

13. ASSIGNMENT AND SUBLETTING OF THE CONTRACT:

The contractor shall not assign or sub-let any part of the contract to any other party or agency without the written consent of GIPCL.

14. DEDUCTIONS FROM CONTRACT PRICE:

All costs, charges or expenses which GIPCL may have paid for which, under the contract the contractor are liable, will be claimed by GIPCL. All such claims shall be paid by the contractor within 15 days failing which the same shall be deducted from the contractor's bills.

15. SETTLEMENT OF DISPUTES:

Any disputes or difference between parties arising out of the contract to the extent possible shall be settled amicably between the parties. If amicable settlement cannot be reached all the disputed issues shall be resolved through arbitration according to the provisions of Indian Arbitration Act, 1940.

The place of arbitration shall be at Surat. Work under the contract shall be continued by the contractor during arbitration proceedings unless GIPCL shall order suspension thereof or any part thereof in writing or unless the matter in such work cannot possibly be continued unless the decision of the Arbitration proceedings is obtained.

16. INTERPRETATION OF CLAUSE:

In case of disputes as regards interpretation of any of the clause or specification, the decision of GM (SLPP), GIPCL will be final and binding on the contractor.

17. EMPLOYEE'S COMPENSATION INSURANCE:

The contractor shall take all risk Insurance Policy to cover his workmen, staff applicable under the Workmen Compensation Act 1923 or any amendment thereof also insurance cover for third party liability. The contractor shall keep GIPCL indemnified from all liabilities arising out of his action in pursuance of this contract. The E.C.Policy should be obtained from Surat Jurisdiction and shall be assigned to GIPCL.

18. STATUTORY REQUIREMENTS:

- a. The contractor shall be solely responsible for any accident to his workers and should adhere to all rules / regulations as per labour laws of Government and other statutory laws as applicable.
- b. The contractor will have to insure his workmen / supervisors etc. under Group Insurance Scheme, so that there will not be any problem after any accident and it may also cover the liability under Workmen Compensation Act.
- c. The contractor should register himself under the Contract Labour Act, Workmen Compensation Act and PF Act and submit the copy of registration certificate and should possess the same from the date of commencement of work, failing which the contract is liable to be cancelled. The E.C.Policy copy should be submitted to GIPCL before commencement of work and Labour License should be obtained within one week from the date of issue of Form-V. Contractor should apply for Form-V immediately after receipt of LOI. A copy of Labour License shall be submitted to GIPCL, HR & Admn. Dept.
- d. The contractor will be responsible for compliance of all statutory rules, regulation, and act enforce from time frame framed by the government such as Factory Act, Workmen Compensation Act, Minimum Wages payment Act. Provident Fund Act, Payment of Bonus Act, Labour Law Act in respect of employees engaged by him for the work and shall have to maintain necessary records. In case any amount becomes due to be payable by him to his employees or to the Government under the above rules, regulation, Acts, GIPCL reserves the right to recover the same from him and pay to the concerned employee. Documentary evidence of deposit of PF paid in the preceding month shall have to be produced by the contractor along with the monthly RA bill of succeeding month. Records as per the provisions of various statutory Acts will have to be maintained by the contractor and submitted as and when required.
- e. All contractors' employee should maintain due discipline and respect local sentiments. GIPCL reserves the right for recall of any contractor's employee for undesirable conduct and such employee shall be removed from site within 24 hours and a suitable replacement arranged in his place.

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19. FACILITIES TO BE PROVIDED BY GIPCL:

1. Electricity & water at nearest available one point free of cost. Further distribution to be done by contractor at their cost.
2. Workshop facility as available at site only.
3. First aid facility as available.
4. For lifting & shifting of heavy items only, hydra & tractor shall be provided by GIPCL free of cost subject to availability.
5. No accommodation shall be provided at GPCL Township. Party has to make required accommodation on their own

20. ITEMS TO BE PROVIDED BY GIPCL FREE OF COST:

1. Pipes, fitting, valves, flanges, structural steel for support.
2. Primer and Paints

Party shall utilize the material judiciously and shall avoid undue waste. The contractor has to collect above items from GIPCL store/warehouse. Lifting & shifting arrangement has to be made by contractor. Distance about 1 km.

21. GENERAL SAFETY CAUSES:

- a. Contractor shall issue safety shoes and safety helmet of IS standard to all his workers immediately after execution of the contract. Other safety gears like ear plug, dust mask, hand gloves, safety goggles, gum boot, full body safety belts, safety net etc. shall be issued and used as per the job requirements. Safety helmet shall be of **YELLOW COLOURS ONLY.**
- b. Contractor should procure safety shoes from reputed company and of reputed brands. Safety shoes will be issued every year. Safety shoe should be Heat, water, oil and chemical resistant, anti slippery sole 15298- 2002.
- c. It is duty of contractor to ensure that their workers are wearing required PPEs as per work requirement. Contractor should ensure that their workers are wearing Safety helmet, safety shoes, dust mask, goggles, ear plug etc. throughout the contract period. Failing which GIPCL will take strict disciplinary action on contractor.
- d. Contractor will reissue these PPEs in case of damage or missing of the same. Replacement shall be made immediately.
- e. All PPEs shall be made as per relevant Indian standards or international standard. Copy of standards to be submitted.

22. SAFETY NORMS TO BE OBSERVED BY CONTRACTOR:

The Contractor shall observe and comply, with regard to his workmen working at the SLPP site, the safety norms as per the safety operating standards.

1. The Contractor shall ensure that his workmen are informed and trained regarding the safety standards to be adopted while operating within the SLPP Plant & Mines premises and the Contractor shall brief them regarding the same and use of the Personal Protective Equipment ('PPE').
2. The Contractor shall issue safety shoes and safety helmet of IS standard to all his workmen immediately on execution of the work and the contractor shall ensure that his workmen wears the protective equipments at all times during the work operation. Brand name for safety shoe & safety helmet shall be suggested by safety representative of SLPP site.
3. It is the duty of contractor to ensure that his workmen are wearing required PPEs as per work requirement. Contractor should ensure that their workers are wearing Safety helmet, safety shoes, dust mask, goggles, ear plug etc. at all times when they are at work throughout the contract period. The contractor has to maintain the PPE issues register with signature of workmen.

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4. Other safety gears like ear plug, dust mask, hand gloves, safety goggles, gum boots, full body safety uniform and belts, safety net etc. shall be issued and used as per the job requirements. Safety helmet shall be of YELLOW COLOUR ONLY.
Contractor will procure safety shoes & safety helmet from a reputed company with at least 12 months' guarantee and shall produce the guarantee certificate and IS standard certificate to the safety department. Contractor should purchase safety shoes of reputed brands. Safety shoes will be issued every year. IS certificate and guarantee certificate must be obtained from the vendor and submitted to the Safety department. Safety shoes should be heat, water, oil and chemical resistant, having an anti-slippery sole of 15298- 2002 make.
5. Contractor will reissue these PPEs in case of damage or misplacement of the same. Replacement shall be made immediately.
6. The contractor shall be responsible for providing first aid or emergency medical help and treatment to his workmen in the event of any accident or injury.
7. If it is observed that contractor is not issuing required PPEs timely and that of required quality, GIPCL will issue the required PPEs to contract workers and back charge the same with 25% overhead charges of GIPCL.
8. All lifting tools and tackles shall be duly certified by competent person in conformity with the statutory requirements and certificate in form no. 10 as per rule 60 of Gujarat Factories Rules, 1963 and section 29 of the Factories Act, 1948 shall be submitted every year before using such tools and tackles. In case of purchase of new lifting tools and tackles, form no. 10 as per the said rules shall be submitted before they are taken into use. All lifting tools and tackles shall be of reputed make having International manufacturing standard and shall be maintained in proper and workable condition. The Contractor shall nominate one Safety Officer with required qualification for supervising the daily job/ shutdown jobs for observing and maintaining the safety aspects at site. He is solely responsible for any safety measures during maintenance work. He has to ensure that all the workmen working at site are equipped with essential PPE's and proper safety arrangement is made at the SLPP site.
9. After mobilization of any tools & tackles to site, which includes chain pulley blocks, D-shackles, wire ropes, winch machines, Mobile crane, Hydra etc. shall be offered for inspection with all above statutory test certificate before using at site for any work. They should use all tools and tackles only after certification by GIPCL representative/safety officer.
10. When working at height, working on ceiling or roof covered with fragile materials, full body harness, safety belt, ladders and crawling boards shall be used to prevent accident. Further, during working on height, contractor should arrange proper scaffolding of still pipes, safety net, full body safety belt, fall arrestor system etc. Advice and instructions of engineer in charge/ safety in charge shall be strictly complied with in this regard. All necessary safety precautions shall be taken by the contractor to prevent accident and personnel injuries while working on height.
11. Flash back arrestors made of reputed manufacturer shall be provided on cutting torch, on DA cylinders and on O2 cylinder. Cylinder caps also required for handling the cylinders at the work at height area. Gas cylinders shall be transferred through gas cylinder trolley only with cylinder cap and stored up right (vertical) position only. All gas cylinders shall be hydro tested / certified as per gas cylinder rules 2004. Gas cylinders shall be stored, handled as per gas cylinder rules 2004.

12. All vehicles shall be operated by licensed drivers only. All vehicles' PUC to be tested as per Government approved RTO guidelines. All Vehicles must be parked in Parking space designated by GIPCL. If any vehicle is found inside the plant premises other than the parking area such vehicles shall be handed over to Security dept. and their entry shall be cancelled for movement inside the plant premises with immediate effect.
14. All electrical equipment shall be in good condition and free from any defect. Electrical tools & equipments i.e. welding machine, grinding and drill machine etc. may be checked by the electrical engineer of the contractors regularly, every six month at least and report to be submitted to concerned HOD and safety depts.
15. During hot work, contractor will use fire curtains like asbestos sheets or fire blankets to prevent falling and spreading of sparks and hot material on and around the work area. Contractor will procure and use such items. ELCB / RCCB shall be provided with rating of 9-30 miliampere on welding machine and all portable power tools.
16. The contractor shall fill – up Incident notification form (S-I), Incident Investigation form (S-II) and near miss report within time limit as specified in forms, if any accident, Incident, near miss occurred while working at SLPP site.
17. Major AMC / ARC contractor (Where the man power strength is more than 50 and above) should appoint / nominate one qualified safety officer and he shall be responsible for addressing all the safety related aspects of execution of contract jobs and he will in close co ordination with safety officer of SLPP and attend all safety related meeting such as safety committee, on job safety training etc. Where the contractual man power is less than 50, the site in charge of the contractor will act as a safety officer and he will perform all the duties of safety officer as mentioned above.
18. No loose connection / joints allowed in electrical cables during performance of any kind of job.
19. Safety shoes to be issued to female employees also.
20. All the vehicles shall be fit as per RTO guidelines and valid fitness certificate is required as per RTO guidelines.
21. The Contractor shall comply all the new requirements related with safety as informed by the HOD / Safety department from time to time.
22. Penalty to be imposed for Violation of safety norms is proposed as follows :-

The Contractor & Contract workmen shall strictly adhere to Safety standards / Guidelines as per practices. The list provided below is an indicative list to explain the principles behind safety practice. If the contract workmen fail to comply with safety standards as per category A, B & C below, penalty shall be levied on the contractor as per the table mentioned below:

23. OTHER TERMS AND CONDITION OF THE CONTRACT:

1. All tools, tackles & scaffolding materials required to execute the contract are in the scope of the contractor. The contractor should ensure that tools are in healthy condition. All consumable items i.e. cotton, kerosene oil, wire brushes, gases (Oxygen, D/A, Argon) and welding electrode would be in the scope of the contractor.

2. Provision of scaffolding for piping work will be in the scope of the contractor. The scaffolding shall be with pipes, clamps & metallic jallies
3. The welding electrode should be approved by GIPCL prior to use after award of contract. If any equipments or part are found damaged due to negligence / fault of contractor, the cost of such damages shall be recovered from the contractors bill.
4. Electrodes shall be of D&H, ESAB, Adani, Orelincon, and L&T only. Other than this subjects to GIPCL approval.
5. The successful bidder shall nominate / authorize a person in writing as Site in charge to coordinate with GIPCL engineer and should bear overall responsibility of contract. Such person shall function from site office of contractor as SLPP. The decision of the Engineer in charge shall be final and binding on the contractor for defining the terms and condition included in this contract.
6. Inspection of work may be done at any time by engineer in charge or his authorized representative, if the work is not found satisfactory, engineers in charge reserves the right to take suitable action.
7. Arrangement for lighting at the work spot has to be made by the Contractor. He has to arrange all lighting equipments such as power cable, hand lamps. The contractor has to take prior approval for taking electrical power supply.
8. The welder deployed for welding of joints must have valid certificate and also should pass the welding test conducted by GIPCL before start of work.
9. The supervisor deployed by the successful bidder should be qualified & capable to handle the labour & job successfully. He should co-ordinate with GIPCL engineer in cordial & polite manner.
10. The successful bidder has to do quality job. GIPCL shall not compromise in quality. In case of poor quality of work the contractor may be asked to rework the job.
11. The successful bidder has to take group insurance policy for their workmen. The contractor has to submit / labour license and PF account no. to the E-I-C before start the work.
12. The entire scrape generated should be disposed off to the scrap yard or any other designated place as instructed by E-I-C.
13. Contractor must fulfill all the safety hazards. He has to arrange sufficient safety helmet, safety belts, etc. failings this E-I-C is authorized to remove any person(s) or machinery(s) if felt as safety hazard. If the contractor \repeatedly violates safety rules E-I-C may take necessary action against the contractor.
14. If at any time, it is found that the manpower deployed by the successful bidder is not sufficient and they are not in a position to deploy required manpower due to any reason, GIPCL shall have the option to deploy the workman or make alternative arrangement at the risk and cost of the successful bidder.
15. **Defect liability period:** The defect liability period will be 12 (twelve) months from the completion of the erection and commissioning of the pipe line. All defects occurring in attended job during defect liability period must be rectified by the successful bidder free of cost.
17. Along with every monthly bill, party has to submit material re-consolation report & balance items to be stored properly or returned to warehouse.
16. In case contractor manpower has to sit idle due to non availability of work front, isolation problems, operation constraint etc, no idle charge shall be provided during executing the jobs.
